The Congress will be accredited with CME credit points.

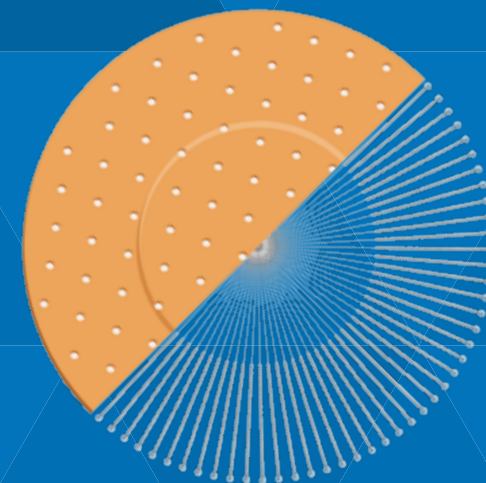
